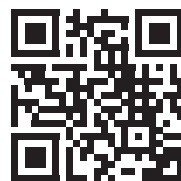

Why The Ripple Effect (TREWO) is Important to Us All

Health continues to be a major concern for all Canadians. TREWO's goal is to mobilize individuals at the government, corporate and community levels to inspire change where it matters most – at a personal level. Think of it as a ripple effect. A drop of information that challenges the status quo, that spreads in ever-widening circles to generate significant results, and help Canada maintain its global status as the gold standard in health care.

About Us and Our Mission

The Ripple Effect Wellness Organization (TREWO) is a registered Canadian charity dedicated to educating and empowering Canadians to lead healthy lives through proactive decision making. Founded by Order of Canada recipient Dr. Sudi Devanesen and the late Ravi S. Juneja, TREWO bridges the care gap between physicians, patients and the community through education training and funding of several programs.

Some Key TREWO Projects

Fundraising Activities: Each year TREWO has organized fundraising events such as our very successful Imagination Ball, with over 600 attendees.

Trillium Health Partners Foundation (THPF)

A donation of \$50,000 was made to the THP Foundation to help construct an assessment and resuscitation room within the ER of Credit Valley Hospital and was opened in 2018. We donated \$20,000 to Trillium Health Partners for personal protective equipment during the Covid pandemic. To date, an additional \$130,000 has been donated to THPF to support The Falls Prevention Program, Seniors Health Care and Cancer Care.

Roofs for the Roofless

1. TREWO has also extended its reach internationally by donating over \$70,000 for medical and health services to the disadvantaged and poverty stricken seniors in several villages south of Chennai.
2. The existing Kochhar Endowment Fund continues to fund a number of scholarships for students at the Rural Community College.
3. The Shah Family Foundation is generously supporting a breakfast and lunch program and additional scholarships for students at the Rural Community College.

Community & Youth Mental Health Programs

I.M.P.A.C.T. (Inspire, Mentor, Prepare, Adapt, Connect, Transform) - Launched September 2025

With the support of the Gloria Bayliss Foundation, a peer-led, life skills, education program empowering students with critical social, emotional, and leadership skills. A mentorship model where high school students train younger students using an activity-based curriculum. Focus areas include mental health awareness, self-regulation, social media literacy, resilience, and decision-making.

HEALTH Lit - Launched September 2024

The growing HealthLIT team has been hard at work since the Gala, on diversifying our means of disseminating health education and awareness content via our social media channels. We've been focused on effectively reaching our youth and young professional audiences. Our team releases content on a monthly to biweekly basis comprising Health Hacks and WOW webinar highlight reels, and our new "Let's Talk" segment which involves short conversations with medical experts on various relevant health topics and trends.

Youth Group

TREWO has launched our Youth Seminar initiative, designed to inspire, support, and empower young people as they navigate the complex world we live in today. Our teams have also played an important role in fundraising through auctions and raffles, helping ensure that TREWO's programs continue to reach and support those who need them most.

LEVOS

TREWO is helping with the academic development of an AI generated App to address the issue of access to primary care screening and monitoring for patients who have minimal contact with healthcare providers both in Canada and Rural India.

Webinar Outreach Wing (WOW)

The Webinar Outreach Wing (WOW) has been keeping our global community connected and well informed about health and wellness over the past 7 years. Our acclaimed experts provide clarity, reassurance and advice to our audience of up to 400 attendees each webinar. In 2025 we conducted four webinars. Also in 2025, WOW supported the Roofs for the Roofless program by funding the installation of solar panels at the Roofs Community College.

Our Goals For 2026 & Beyond

TREWO continues to explore and fund partnerships in the community. TREWO will also create a Ravi S. Juneja Memorial Fund for Cancer Care & Research in memory of TREWO's Co-Founder.
